## NOTICE

THAT IN AN EGALITARIAN JAMAICA PLAIN IT WOULD BE THE LAW THAT

### Gentrification Would Be Illegal

Doctors, scientists & professionals would be welcome to live in Jamaica Plain, **but** the law would be that:

- No resident in good standing of Jamaica Plain shall be coerced by economic hardship or any other means into leaving their home in Jamaica Plain unwillingly.
- Every resident in good standing has an equal right to **freely** take products from the economy (housing, food, clothing, services, etc.) according to need and reasonable desire, or to receive scarce products equitably rationed according to need (nobody needs to be somebody else's landlord to live well).
- All persons are in good standing unless the local Assembly of Egalitarians\* determines that, after taking into account the particular circumstances and reasonableness, they are violating the principle of "from each according to ability, to each according to need." Those not in good standing can only beg or barter for things.

\*The Assembly meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month, 7:30-8:30 PM at the Nate Smith House (155 Lamartine St., Jamaica Plain). An egalitarian is any person who supports:

- **Equality** (in the sense of "no rich and no poor," not "equal opportunity" to get richer than others) and
- **Mutual Aid** (or **Solidarity**, meaning helping each other, not being pitted against others in competition by an oppressor to control us)

Mission: All egalitarians (and only egalitarians) of Jamaica Plain are invited to the Assembly to discuss how to promote public understanding of what egalitarianism is, why it's much better than the *status quo*, and how to build the egalitarian revolutionary movement. In an egalitarian society the Local Assembly of Jamaica Plain Egalitarians would be the **ONLY** body that makes laws people in Jamaica Plain would have to obey. One thing we do is write and post examples of such laws so people can see how much better egalitarianism is.
