THAT IN AN EGALITARIAN BRIGHTON

All Health Care Would Be Free

All persons in good standing* would receive all of their health care **for free.**

People in good standing deserve to receive all of their health care—of the highest quality (equitably rationed according to need in the case of scarcity)—for free. Why? Because the people in good standing, by their work for the economy, collectively produce all health care, from building the clinics and hospitals and medical schools and maintaining and cleaning them, growing the food and building the homes and providing the water and electrical service and teaching the K-12 subjects and providing the child care and so on and so forth *ad infinitum* without which there could be no doctors or nurses or clinics or hospitals (or any other man-made thing of value).

* All persons are in good standing unless the local Assembly of Egalitarians** determines that, after taking into account the particular circumstances and reasonableness, they are violating the principle of “from each according to ability, to each according to need.”

**The Assembly meets the 2nd Wednesday of each month, 7:00-8:00 PM at the PSF Community Center, 640 Washington St. (Oak Sq.), Brighton. An egalitarian is any person who supports:

- **Equality** (in the sense of “no rich and no poor,” not “equal opportunity” to get richer than others) and
- **Mutual Aid** (or **Solidarity**, meaning helping each other, not being pitted against others in competition by an oppressor to control us)

Mission: All egalitarians (and only egalitarians) of Brighton are invited to the Assembly to discuss how to promote public understanding of what egalitarianism is, why it’s much better than the *status quo*, and how to build the egalitarian revolutionary movement. In an egalitarian society the Local Assembly of Brighton Egalitarians would be the ONLY body that makes laws people in Brighton would have to obey. One thing we do is write and post examples of such laws so people can see how much better egalitarianism is.
