## DIVIDE AND RULE IN THE U.S.A.

The Left and the Right work as a team on behalf of the Rich to pit ordinary Americans against each other along race lines.

The Left unjustly accuses working class whites of being racists, just because they're white. The Left lies. It says whites benefit when non-whites are treated worse by the police and employers. The Left demands that whites give up this supposed benefit, what the Left calls "white privilege." The Left is dead wrong! (So is the Right—see below.)

Whites as well as non-whites are **harmed** by racial discrimination. Its purpose is to undermine solidarity between whites and non-whites, to create mistrust and resentment between them so that Big Money can dominate and control ALL races of ordinary people. **It is no "white privilege" to be dominated and controlled by Big Money this way.** An injury to one is an injury to **all**. But the Left disagrees. In the name of "anti-racism," the Left treats ordinary whites as the enemy. This is why they blocked and deliberately pissed off the mainly white commuters on I-93. The Left gives the Right exactly what it needs—white people who are angry at "anti-racists."

The Right (no doubt secretly thanking the Left) welcomes these whites with open arms. The Right tells them, "Your anger is totally justified. The Left is wrong to bad mouth our police force. The police are only doing what common sense requires to deal with those criminal races of people. Anti-racism is really just anti-white."

The Right slanders blacks and Hispanics as criminals and urges whites to support police practices that are racially biased against non-whites. The Left slanders whites as racists and urges blacks and Hispanics to regard them as the enemy. The Left and the Right work together this way to foment a race war!

This is how DIVIDE AND RULE IN THE U.S.A. works. It keeps the rich in power. It's why the 400 richest Americans own more wealth than half of all Americans combined, even though most Americans know this is terribly wrong.

We need an egalitarian revolution to remove the rich from power and have real not fake democracy with no rich and no poor. This is what it takes to abolish divide and rule in the U.S.A. Good news: most people want this revolution (see our website for the evidence.)
